Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another. Gracious God,





¹⁰The lions are in want and suffer hunger, but those who seek the LORD lack nothing that is good.


²²O LORD, you redeem the life of your servants, and those who put their trust in you will not be punished.

⁹"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.


¹⁰"Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.


Lord, remember us in your kingdom and teach us to pray.

Here we remember those who have gone before us.




