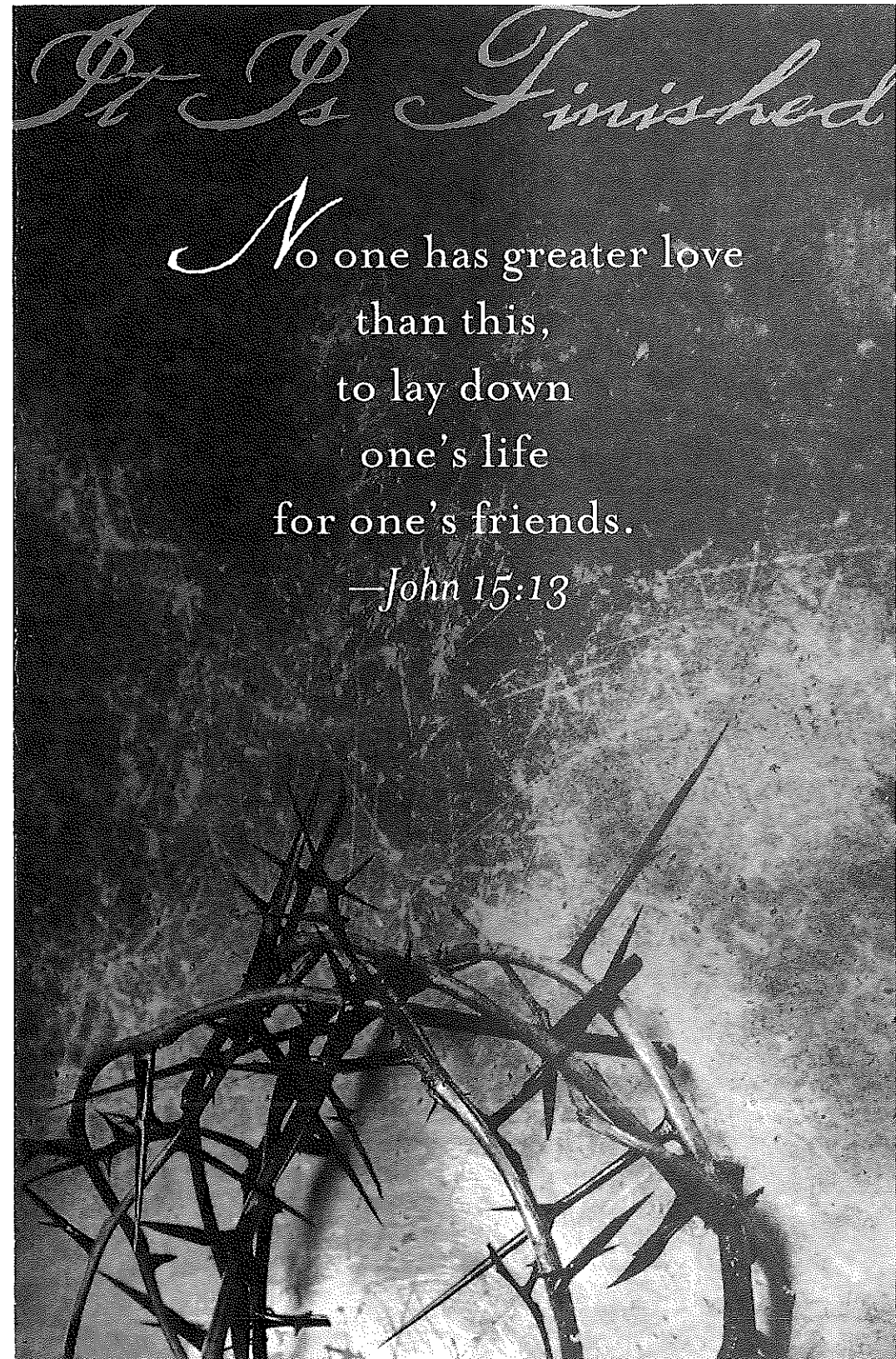
EASTER EGG HUNT is tomorrow morning at 10:00 a.m. sharp on the
