



"Trauma & Crisis to Hope & Resilience"

What: Did you miss the first session? Grief, anger, fear, and apathy are still just a few of the emotions people are navigating. This class will explore these emotions and talk about crisis care. Each session is independent. The class is offered for free.

Notes from the Introductory Session:

Center yourself with, "The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you...do not be afraid" (Deuteronomy 31:8). This combined with the idea of "ministry of presence" is powerful: just show up and be Available, Affirming, and Authentic. Nothing a carer can say will undo the trauma of the crisis, but silence can allow for processing by all participants.

Digging deeper: Work to know you own story and emotional realities to be a "less anxious" carer, a wounded healer and not a walking wounded. Sometimes it helps to follow Critical Incident Stress Debriefing and ask: What did you do? What thoughts were going through your head? How did you react, physically, emotionally, spiritually?--these reactions are normal reactions to an abnormal situation, stress!
